We are excited to announce that **pile driving** for the east portion of the new bridge structure on McHenry Avenue over the Stanislaus River began **today, Friday, June 30**. A video of the pile driving will be posted later on the website. The photos included in this newsletter will also be available on the website.

The McHenry Avenue Corridor Improvements project will enhance safety, inter-regional traffic circulation, and air quality.

Construction began in May 2017 and is on schedule to be completed by mid-2020.

Ongoing Work

- The majority of the construction work site has been cleared of debris.
- Pile driving for the east portion of the new bridge structure on McHenry Avenue over the Stanislaus River.

Upcoming Construction Activities July 2017

- Crews will install stone columns into the ground to strengthen loose soil around the new bridge. When soil becomes loose and saturated, it behaves like liquid during earthquakes, also known as "liquefaction." The stone columns will help prevent soil liquefaction around the bridge.
- Electrical work for temporary roadway lighting.
